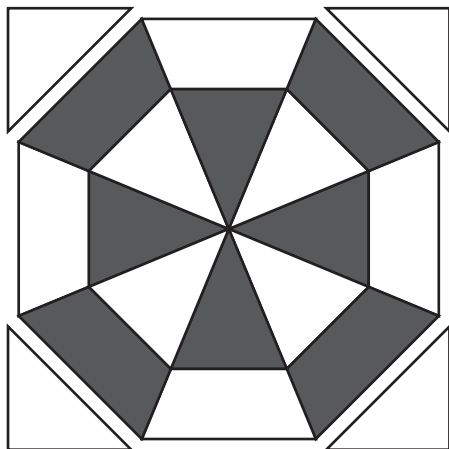

## 4 - Triangle Units

Place a strip set A right sides together with a strip set B so the seams nestle together.

Using the template provided cut 12 units.  
The leftover triangles can be saved and used for a different project.

Sew triangle units in pairs, press seam allowances one way. **ORIENTATION MATTERS!**

Sew two pairs together so they alternate A block and B block. Press seam allowances one way.

## 5 - Block Assembly

Take two of the previously sewn units and match them together at center seam and sew  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance, being sure the points match. Press all seam allowances one direction, except the last seam you sewed. That seam should be pressed open and the very center of the block should be flattened out with a hammer.

Take a matching  $2 \frac{7}{8}$ " light square, cut in half diagonally, Sew to each outside dark fabric to make a Mystic Maze block. The block should measure  $7 \frac{1}{2}$ " square, including seam allowances

Make 25 Mystic Maze blocks.
